- Sufficient time for monitoring site safety and operatives at work
- Ensuring refresher training is given on topics required
- Promoting health and safety awareness through training
- Ensuring staff have the right skills, knowledge and ability to carry out the works given
- Maintaining and providing safe work equipment
- Investigate accident records and identify trends to improve safety performance
- Commitment to 100% face fit testing
- Ensuring all staff have up to date information on COVID-19 and the procedures that are needed to be followed
- Providing safe and healthy work conditions for the prevention of work-related injury and ill-health (as appropriate to our business and risks)
- Consultation and participation of workers with a separate policy established

Our health and safety policy will be reviewed annually to monitor its effectiveness and to ensure that it reflects changes within the business and updates.
